Offense: Aggravated Roberry

On Monday, February 13, 2017, at approximately 11:00PM, TSU Police Officers were dispatched to University Towers in reference to a delayed robbery report that reportedly happened around 8:15PM. Upon arrival, officers met with a Texas Southern Student who stated he was walking in the 3900 Block of Canfield Street, off campus, on his way to the store and was approached by two black males who forced him inside of a white car. He stated while he was inside of the vehicle one of the males pointed a black handgun at his midsection demanding his phone, chains and wallet. The complainant complied and surrendered his belongings. The males then forced him out of the vehicle and threatened to shoot him if he reported what happened.

It should be noted it was three suspects; two in the front and one in the back of the vehicle where the complainant was made to sit. The complainant stated he did not get a good look at any of the suspects nor was he able to determine what type of vehicle the suspects were in.

Texas Southern University Police and Houston police Department are working together to locate the suspects.
