Campus Crime Alert

Release Date: February 14, 2017

Offense: Aggravated Robbery

On Tuesday, February 14, 2017, at approximately 11:35 AM, TSU Police Officers met with a student in regards to a delayed robbery report that reportedly happened in the early morning around 12:50 AM. The complainant stated that she was walking to the entrance of Tierwester Oaks Building 4 and was approached by two males in a dark colored sedan. The complainant stated that the male in the passenger seat showed her what appeared to be marijuana and asked if she wanted to buy some. When she said no the suspect asked to use her phone. The complainant asked why and the suspect motioned towards his lap. She looked and saw that he had a black handgun in the suspects lap. The complainant surrendered her phone. As the suspects began to pull off the complainant attempted to grab the door of the vehicle and fell. The vehicle fled in an unknown direction.

The suspect driving was described as a dark complected black male with a short afro style haircut, the passenger was described as a light skinned black male with a low hair cut wearing a blue shirt.
