On Saturday, August 29, 2020, at approximately 3:36 PM, TSU DPS responded to the 2900 Block of Rosewood Street in reference to an incident of domestic violence being investigated by Houston Police Department. Officers learned that a woman and child had been held against their will by the woman's former boyfriend.

Upon the arrival of TSU Police the suspect was detained leaving the woman and child safe. The suspect was subsequently arrested for Assault Family Violence and transported to jail.
