Dr. Zantel D. Nichols is a tenure-track Assistant Professor in Communication Studies in the School of Communication at Texas Southern University, Houston, TX. Dr. Nichols specializes in research in community health partnerships, grassroots organizing, diversity equity & inclusion and corporate social responsibility. Dr. Nichols teaches courses in organizational communication, organizational behavior & structure, interpersonal communication, leadership, and communication theory. In 2017, Dr. Nichols received her Ph.D. in Organizational Communication from University of Nebraska at Lincoln, an M.A. in Communication from Texas Southern University (2004), and a B.A. in Journalism & Mass Communication from the University of Iowa (1992). Dr. Nichols has served in the roles of MA in Communication Graduate Director (2018-2022), Basic-course Coordinator, Department of Speech Program Coordinator, and a member of the General Education Core Committee.
