My goal is pointed, and the trajectory of my aim is unwavering: I have always known that interpreting written words and converting them into moving pictures were the elements that defined for me: Art in its truest form. But it all starts with becoming a creative, screenplay writer and filmmaker. The driving force that keeps the embers in me glowing at full blast is the platform I have teaching these acquired skills to Texas Southern University students plying in the same arena.

EXPERIENCE:

Adjunct Professor (TSU) 2014 to present. Since 1984, I have written over fifty feature length screenplays...some of them as a hired gun...meaning that I have been contracted to write screenplays for independent filmmakers over a period of two decades. Some of my screenplays have been adapted into full-fledged 400 hundred-page scorchers like the books titled, BLUE MARTINI, and BARGERSVILLE, THE 4TH GATE. It is in the same vein that some of screenplays have been made into feature length films...ten motion pictures and counting. A couple of those films have notable Hollywood faces like the late, **Thomas Mikhail Ford** of the famous Martin Show, **Kool Mo Dee**, the famous rap musician, to behemoths **Eric Roberts** of Dark Knights, and The Specialist fame; and **Anthony Ray Parker** of the Matrix fame. In each of these films with the notables, I was the writer and Director of these films. **Lonestar Deception**, the film that featured Eric Roberts and Anthony Ray Parker won Houston's World fest film festival for Best Film.

In 1986, I served as a production Assistant in a television series shot in Houston...**the Red. Duke's story**. That awakened the docile, dormant beast of art

resident in me. Since then, I have never looked back. With that one experience, coupled with the unavoidable stints of watching bad movies in the days of yore, I launched into that foray of writing screenplays. In all, I was registered in more than a dozen, weekend screenplay seminars back in the eighties as a way of sharpening my skills.

It paid off: In 1994, I wrote and Directed my first feature length film titled **Material Witness**, which Dr. Chris Ulasi produced.

The very next year, 1995, Dr. Chris Ulasi and I followed that up with **The Kangaroo**, featuring some of Hollywood greats, like **Thomas Mikhail Ford**, and **Charnele Brown** of the A Different World fame.

Come 1996, we were good to go on another production...a political action drama, titled **The Stalk Exchange (419)** This one film was tailored to appease the taste buds of most African film consumers. It was our first incursion into a territory that would later become the world's second-best consumers of films from the diaspora.

The experiences in writing and making motion pictures never slowed; my production company followed these successes up with a slew of other noteworthy films, written and directed by me; **Return of The Exile; Ricochet**; **Blood and Destiny; Gem of The Rainforest**; and the award winner monster, **Pound of Flesh**.

It did not take long; offers were coming in to write for fledgling production companies. They saw, in real time, my expedition into the cold lands of Canada to receive a film award. I was called in to make a pitch for a hired gun screenplay I had written titled, at the time, **The Candidate**. A year and a half later, the film The Candidate was in the can...with a new name, **Lonestar Deception**. This was the film that garnered incredible awards on the international scene. The film is also available...streaming on Hulu, Amazon Prime, and Vudu.

And then, **Jurica Road**, the movie of exquisite, but flaming diatribe on race happened. This scorching tale is as dark in her precepts as one would find in the rungs and crannies of Hell proper. This film is also available on Amazon Prime.
