[Other nominees Hype Williams Benny Boom Little X] Nominated for 2008 Video Of The Year Ozone Awards for Lupe Fiasco "Hip Hop Saved My Life". And lastly Teeth was nominated 2009 BET Hip-Hop awards in the category of Best Video Dorrough "Ice Cream Paint Job". Dr. Teeth work is not limited to Houston base rap artist but ranges from R&B to Rock & Roll having worked with artist such as Lupe Fiasco, Ludacris, T.I. Lil Wayne, to soul singer Lloyd and KeAnthony AKA "Cruna" to Rock Legends Kings X.

In 2018 John D. Tucker aka "Dr. Teeth" bring his talent and experience to narrative filmmaking with his comedy short PAS HONTEUX. Tucker was able to bring together Jean-Luc Godard & Françios Truffaut French New Wave techniques and modern hip hop culture to tell a truly unique story. PAS HONTEUX Tucker brings together his passion for music, together with his passion for French new wave cinema. La Nouvelle Vague's use of new wave techniques was an immense inspiration for Tucker during the making of this film. Along with the work of Charles Burnett's Italiano Neorealism-influenced "Killer of Sheep". PAS HONTEUX is the story of a young African American slacker that wakes up one day speaking French. It's farcical, humorous, and thought provoking. We not only judge people by their looks but also by the way they speak. So, what if a young urban African American suddenly speaks French? The film must be seen to be believed. It jumps from modern hip hop inspired visuals to high contrast new wave bringing new meaning to both styles of filmmaking. The film stars Travis LaBranch (SHOTS FIRED), Leon Lamar (The Hunger Games: Catching Fire, The Immortal Life Of Henrietta Lacks, American Made), and Javicia Leslie (God Friended Me, MacGyver, Killer Coach), is written by Sundance Alum Marcus J. DCM Produced a segment for the 2010 BET Award called the Package, this segment hosted a short film created and Directed by Dr. Teeth to promote The 2010 BET Award Show to its 106 & Park audience. Sponsored by Starbucks. Starring NBC's Saturday Night Live cast member

Jay Pharro. The promo ran as a weeklong series of short stories concluding live from the red carpet at the BET Awards. DCM is also Producing it 1st featured film starring Mike Epps in his first starring Role the project is entitled Overdraft Produced & Directed By Dr. Teeth A native of Cincinnati, Ohio, John D. Tucker's first love was music. A multitalented musician, Tucker played the piano and percussion instruments as a child and sang in the church choir. He realized at an early age he enjoyed performing, but preferred running the show. This behind the scenes leadership role manifested itself as Tucker matured.

At the outset of his collegiate career, this ingenious video and film professional majored in music at Texas Southern University (TSU). But, as a member of an R&B music group, Tucker began putting together performance demo tapes with the help of the school's telecommunications department. At this point, he realized his true passion resided in film production and changed his major to Telecommunications. Tucker's drive for excellence in the video and film arena was defined as a student. He quickly landed roles directing commercials and assisting on music video shoots. Tucker has worked with world-renowned film and video directors such as Brett Ratner Director of "Money Talks" "Rush Hour 1&2" (video for the feature film "My Vida Loca"), Billie Woodruff (videos for Toni Braxton, Kelly Price, Brian McKnight and Cash Money Millionaires) Doug McHenry and the late George Jackson (for "Jason's Lyric" starring Jada Pinkett Smith and Alan Payne). In addition, Dr.Teeth co-wrote edited and directed his Student film, "21 Crunk Street." Tucker added to his film and video resume working as a sports producer, video photographer and editor for Houston's CBS affiliate, KHOU-11. From there, he moved on to Black Entertainment Television's (BET) Washington, D.C. headquarters, where he produced the award-winning youth program, "Teen Summit." Tucker's team of producers received an NAACP Image Award for Best Children's Programming during his time on the show.

Following his stint with "Teen Summit," he moved into the capacity of senior producer for "Rap City," the longest running daily hip-hop show on television. He was also one of the pioneering producers moving with BET's music programs to New York City. John also created BET's urban superhero character "Ghetto Man" for the popular "Hits from the Streets" programs. As well as redeveloping BET's "Rap City" into "Rap City Tha Bassment" working closely under Music program head Steven Hill and Senior Producer Craig Henry, John's AKA Dr.Teeth created the popular booth/Restroom that all the famous the M.C's performs in at the end of the show.

Nicknamed "Dr. Teeth" for his famous smile, Tucker leveraged his name and talent to form the J.D. Tucker Foundation by bridging the gap between the HBCU resources. Tucker's dream is to bring the talent of the HBCU student to the forefront and empower the student to reach their goals and dreams. Thus he started the HBCU Film Festival. Founded in 1999, The J. D. Tucker Foundation provides Tucker with a vehicle to give back to his beloved Historical Black Colleges & Universities, a principle Tucker has abided by since he has graduated in 1997

The Foundation's mission is to provide scholarship opportunities and advance study in communication at Historically Black Colleges and Universities. The Foundation's signature event, "HBCU Film Festival" is held annually at a hosting HBCU School. Proceeds from the event are donated to the Telecommunications Department of the hosting HBCU. A single parent, John and his son, Joseph, has live throughout the country (Texas, D.C. and New York City). While instilling in his son the importance of responsibility, education and discipline, parenthood has given John the motivation and drive to achieve and succeed in a highly competitive industry.

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
