

SCHOLARSHIPS

Texas Southern University is committed to providing scholarships opportunities so that talented students, no matter their economic circumstances, can achieve their college dream. TSU offers merit-based scholarship programs that recognize outstanding academic achievement that will help to fund your college education- making tuition, fees and housing much more affordable by reducing or even eliminating your out-of-pocket expense.

Each of the programs- The President's Leadership Scholarships, General University Scholarships, Honors Scholarships and The School of Communication Scholarships- will have specific requirements for determining eligibility. These requirements ultimately determine the award amount you receive, which can range from \$500 to as much as \$10,000 per year.

In the School of Communication (SOC), The Dean has made a commitment to offer merit-based and/or need-based scholarships to assist students. Criteria for these scholarships are listed below and students are welcome to apply during the spring semester.

The School of Communication Scholarship Criteria (merit):

- Student must be majoring in one of the communication tracks: Speech Communication, Journalism, Radio, Television and Film or the Entertainment Recording Industry;
- Student must have a minimum G.P.A. of 3.00 or higher and completed 59 credit hours;
- > Student must complete the scholarship application and sign it;
- Student must attach an official transcript to the application;
- > Student must provide proof of community service, involvement and/or outreach;
- Student must provide a 100 word essay explaining why they should receive a scholarship;
- Student needs two letters of recommendation from the School of Communication faculty.

The School of Communication Scholarship Criteria (need):

- Student must be majoring in one of the communication tracks: Speech Communication, Journalism, Radio, Television and Film or the Entertainment Recording Industry;
- > Student must demonstrate a need which can be confirmed through our Financial Aid Department;
- > Student must complete the scholarship application and sign it;
- Student must attach an official transcript to the application;
- Student must provide proof of community service, involvement and/or outreach;
- Student must provide a 100 word essay explaining why they should receive a scholarship;
- > Student needs two letters of recommendation from the School of Communication faculty.

Once all completed information is submitted; the SOC Scholarship Committee will review the information and select qualified students for an interview. After the interview process is complete, the committee will vote on the applicants and submit the names to the Dean of the college for review. Students will be awarded during the fall semester.
